5. Project feasibility & value for money.

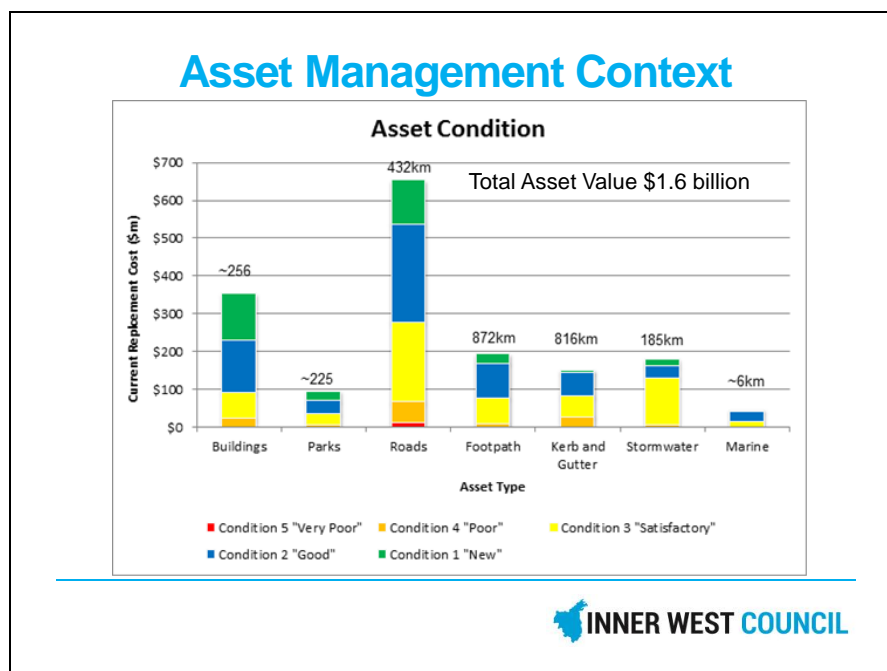

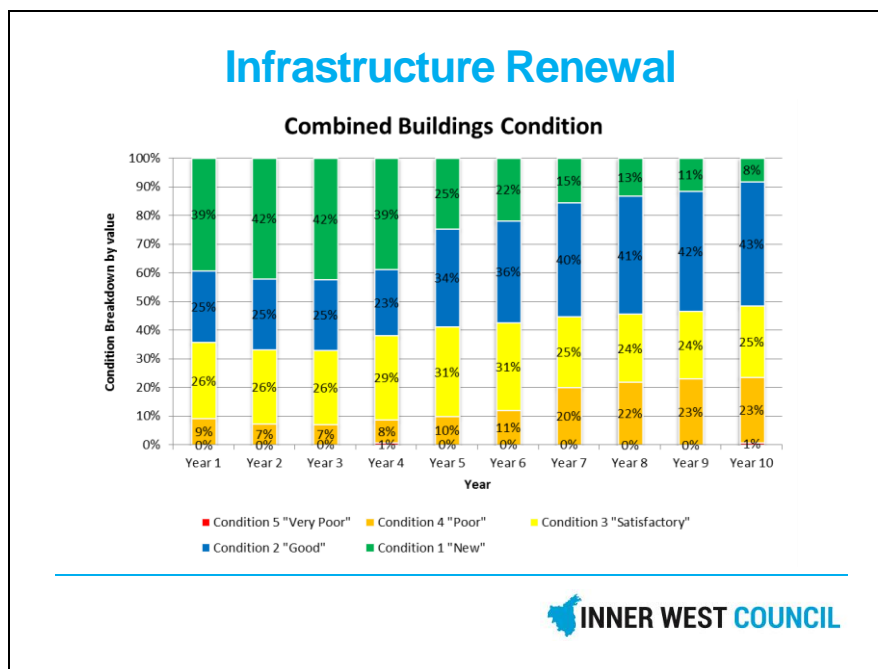

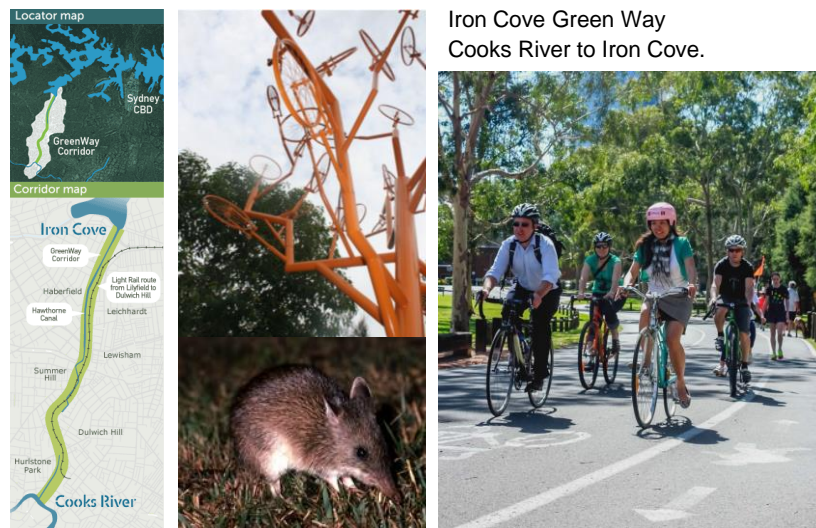

GreenWay & Light Rail corridor “at a glance”



- 5.5 km sustainable transport and urban environmental corridor in Inner West
- links Parramatta & Cooks rivers
- catchment population of 48,000
- connects 6 inner city villages
- mostly public land, owned by 4 local councils & state government

comprises

- 5km Inner West Light Rail extension
- Hawthorne Canal
- cycleways, footpaths and open space
- 16 urban bush care sites
- outdoor classroom for 28 local schools
- recreation, fitness & sports facilities
- public art, cafes & community culture

"a recognisable environmental, cultural and non-polluting transport corridor linking two of Sydney's most important Waterways"





GreenWay Missing Links – 2016 to 2020
