# GreenWay & Light Rail corridor "at a glance"



- 5.5 km sustainable transport and urban environmental corridor in Inner West
- links Parramatta & Cooks rivers
   actahment population of 48 000
- catchment population of 48,000
- · connects 6 inner city villages
- mostly public land, owned by 4 local councils & state government

#### comprises

- 5km Inner West Light Rail extension
- Hawthorne Canal
- · cycleways, footpaths and open space
- 16 urban bush care sites
- outdoor classroom for 28 local schools
   recreation, fitness & sports facilities
- · public art, cafes & community culture

"a recognisable environmental, cultural and non-polluting transport corridor linking two of Sydney's most important Waterways"


