Where is Marrickville Road East?

Council is seeking your input on how to improve the streetscape in order to provide a safe, enjoyable street for all users.



What is happening right now?

Council has identified the critical roles that Marrickville Road East performs as:

- _ a pedestrian connection from the Marrickville town centre to Sydenham station;
- _a strip of commerce and industrial employment; and
- _an interface between existing businesses and the planned Sydenham Station Creative Hub.

Will I be able to have input on the improvements?

You will be able to view the proposed design for Marrickville Road East in April 2017 and then again prior to any construction commences.

At each stage of the design process Council will ask for your comments and will amend the proposals to better meet your needs if possible.

What happens next?

1) Streetscape Improvement Plan - Draft Council will use the community engagement, site analysis and existing council strategies to develop an illustrative plan and detailed strategies for Marrickville Road East streetscape improvement.

2) Public exhibition (mid April)

The plans will be placed on exhibition for 4 weeks to receive final feedback.

3) Finalisation of Plans (end of May)

The feedback will be incorporated to the final plans.

All the changes will be tracked and the final documents will be then sent back to Council for adoption.
