## Ashfield Aquatic Centre refurbishment - Have Your Say

Council is asking residents for feedback on three different options for the refurbishment of Ashfield Aquatic Centre.

- Option 1 is the original tender design of refurbished entrance, café, change rooms, administration area, and new 50m pool, water polo pool, indoor pool and pool hall adjoining the existing pool hall. Activities in the existing community hall would be transferred to a new crèche and meeting room.
- Option 2 includes a new two-storey entrance building with a health and fitness centre, crèche and community meeting rooms as well as improved public domain on Elizabeth Street, plus new 50 metre pool and new indoor 25 metre pool. Option 2 has more community based facilities: leisure area with a splash pad, green space and barbecues
- Option 3 includes a new two-storey entrance building with a health and fitness centre, crèche and community meeting rooms as well as improved public domain on Elizabeth Street. Option 3 also includes new 50 metre pool and a separate water polo pool but does not have a new indoor 25 metre pool and a leisure area with a splash pad, green space and barbecues.

More details for each option are on Council's website. The plan will be finalised by mid-year. Construction will begin in April 2018 and the refurbished Centre will reopen in time for summer 2019/20. Go to Council's website for updates.
