

‘Creating our Inner West 2036’ Photo Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. The Competition Organisers of the *Creating our Inner West 2036 Photo Competition* (the “Competition”) are any Inner West Council staff involved in the organisation and management of the Competition.
2. A panel of judges (the “Panel”) will select the winners of the competition. The Panel will be approved by the Competition Organisers.
3. An entrant must be an individual and not a company or organisation, and must be 24 years of age or younger.
4. All entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the prior permission of their legal parent or guardian over the age of 18 to enter. The parent or guardian of the entrant must read and consent to all Terms and Conditions. The parent or guardian may be called to verify consent and may be required to sign a release at the discretion of the Competition Organisers.
5. Entries must not contain any material that is defamatory, discriminating, obscene, indecent, harassing, or threatening or is otherwise unlawful. Any entry that at the discretion of the Competition Organisers is deemed to be offensive, discriminatory, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing, or threatening, will immediately be disqualified from entering the Competition. The Competition Organisers’ decision in relation to any aspect of the Competition is final. No correspondence and/or discussion will be entered into.
6. In the event that images depict identifiable children under the age of 18, a written release will need to be signed by the parents/guardians of the children depicted.
7. There is no limit to the amount of entries an entrant can submit, however each entrant is only eligible for one prize.
8. The prizes will be twenty (20) \$50 cash gift cards to be spent in the Inner West Council Local Government Area. In the event that there are fewer entrants than allocated prizes, a prize will be awarded to each entrant. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
9. If a winner does not claim their prize within seven days of being contacted by Competition Organisers, the Competition Organisers reserve the right to transfer the award to the next runner up as determined by the Panel.
10. Competition Organisers, the Panel, and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition.
11. All entries and images must be the entrant’s original work and captured within the Inner West Council Local Government Area boundaries.
12. Entries must be submitted via email or Instagram. Entrants over the age of 13 years may enter the Instagram category by tagging #create2036 and @innerwest_council in the photo description. Use of these tags is evidence of the entrant’s consent to these Terms and Conditions. For technical reasons Instagram entries will not be accepted from ‘Private Accounts’.
13. Entries via Instagram are bound by Instagram’s Terms of Use.
14. The Competition Period begins at 9:00am Monday 5 June 2017 AEST, and ends at 11:59pm Monday 17 July 2017 AEST **OR** after the first 250 entries (whichever comes first). Late entries will not be accepted.

15. Winners will be notified via the contact information supplied (for entrants via email) or by Instagram. Winners under the age of 18 will require the permission of a parent or legal guardian to claim their prize.
16. Entrants in the Competition retain all intellectual property rights to their photographs. By entering the Competition, entrants grant Inner West Council an irrevocable, free licence to reproduce winning photographs for publications, advertising and promotional purposes, and grant permission to use first names and photograph descriptions in the same.
17. All personal information gathered by Inner West Council as part of the Competition will be used exclusively for the purposes of running the Competition. Information provided by you will be collected and managed by Inner West Council in accordance with the Privacy and Personal Information Protection (PPIP) Act 1998, under which you have the rights of access and correction.
