What is a local housing strategy




Councils, in consultation with their communities, plan how much housing is needed, where it should be, when it's needed and what it will look like. Inner West Council has prepared a draft Local Housing Strategy for the next 20 years and invites feedback.

Council's draft Local Housing Strategy aims to deliver enough homes of varied types in the right locations to meet the forecast population growth while:

- Respecting our history, culture and character
- Retaining inclusive communities and fair access to housing
- Providing connected neighbourhoods
- Ensuring high quality housing design
- Designing ecologically sustainable housing

The Local Housing Strategy is part of *Our Place Inner West*, a new land use planning framework for Inner West Council, including a Local Strategic Planning Statement, a consolidated Local Environment Plan and Development Control Plans for the Inner West.
