Also in the May Lane Precinct

Council has now completed a 'shared zone' in May Lane following consultation with residents.

The zone is designed to improve safety for pedestrians and slow down vehicles.

It includes a 10 km/h speed limit, raised paved areas at each end of May Lane and at the intersection with Caroline Lane, plus pedestrian refuge islands in Goodsell Street.

Designs have progressed to include a new play space in the middle of the park and a smaller space at the corner of Council and May Streets.

1. The central play space will provide a wide range of fun for all kids. Its location will:
 - combine younger and older children's play in one place
 - allow views of the BMX pump track and the rest of the park
 - create a safe playing space away from the road
2. The new corner space will provide a spot for informal play and relaxation
3. The old playground will be removed.

Camdenville Park Upgrade – the latest design



Community input helped create a Plan of Management and Master Plan for the park which were adopted by Council in July 2014

Now work has started on a \$4 million upgrade.



The upgrade includes:

- A new central play space
- A new BMX pump track
- New paths, seating and shade
- New trees and plants
- Sportsfield upgrade
- Removal of mounds and fences for better visibility and access
- Remediation of site with clean soil cover

The upgrade work will improve the park for users and neighbours by:

- providing temporary access to the BMX track from Bedwin Road to reduce impact on park neighbours while the detention basin area is on hold*
- improving safety through temporary changes to the Bedwin Road fence and removing vegetation
- investigating possible parking solutions for the southern end of Council Street
- planning for a future rain garden and stormwater harvesting in the NE corner of the park
- increasing the distance between the playing fields and the May Street residences

** Due to planning for the State Government WestConnex works on Bedwin Road, upgrade of the adjoining detention basin area and installation of a planted wetland has been put on hold.*
