We have partnered with inclusive playground experts *Touched by Olivia* to deliver a fantastic new playground at Richard Murden Reserve.

This is one of five flagship inclusive playgrounds that we are delivering across the Inner West so that all children, from all backgrounds and with all abilities can benefit from play.

Council is investing \$2 million to deliver this new facility to you.

After a successful community consultation in August 2023, construction is about to begin on the first play space at King George Park, Rozelle.

The second will be at Richard Murden Reserve and we're seeking your ideas and input about how to make it a real benefit for local people. At the same time, Council is also starting to develop a new 10-year plan for the whole of Richard Murden Reserve.

This precious green space is a such an important community asset and we want to continue improving it for you.

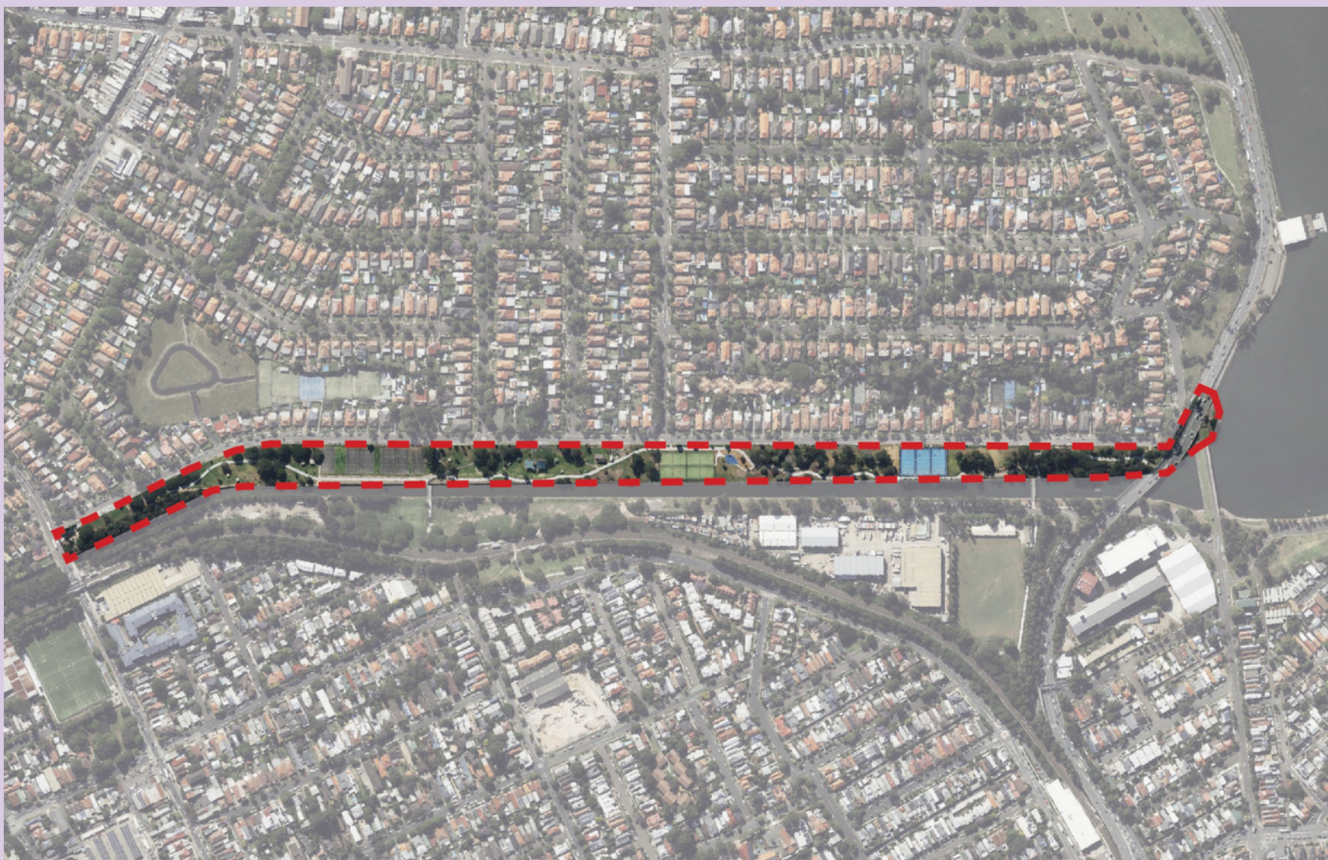
