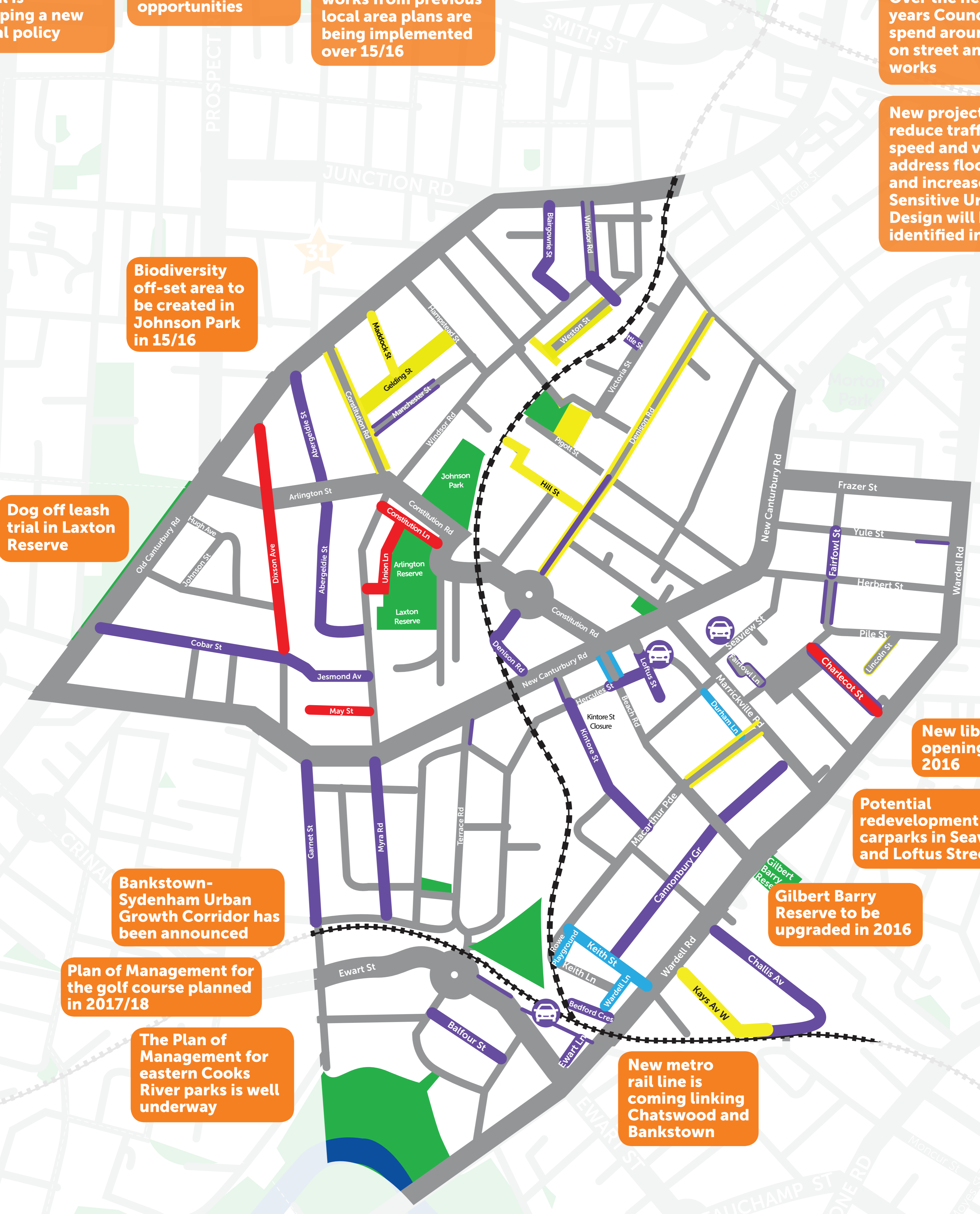
New metro rail line is coming linking Chatswood and Bankstown
